LEAF MARQUE CERTIFICATION: A STRONG STEP TOWARDS RESPONSIBLE AGRICULTURE

Agropecuaria Montelibano celebrates the achievement of the LEAF Marque environmental certification, which validates the company's adherence to sustainable agricultural practices across all its farms. This recognition highlights the company's commitment to environmental conservation through ongoing programs for water harvesting, reforestation, integrated soil management, bee protection, responsible waste management, and circular economy initiatives.

Additionally, it is reinforced by continuous staff training on respect for nature and biodiversity, as well as research conducted by the AGROCIBI Biorregulators Center—key pillars for producing high-quality melons under environmentally responsible conditions.



EMPOWERING HEALTH: PROMOTING CERVICAL CANCER PREVENTION AT AGROLÍBANO

On March 7th and 8th, Agrolibano hosted educational sessions at Santa Rosa Farm as part of its commitment to the overall health of its employees. Nine informational talks were held on the prevention of cervical cancer, reaching 515 individuals.

The sessions covered the importance of early detection, risk factors, prevention methods, and access to screenings such as cytology tests.

This initiative aims to empower women with essential information to take charge of their health and prevent diseases.

AGROLÍBANO CERTIFIES 12 EMPLOYEES IN TIG WELDING

On April 8th, Agrolibano, in partnership with INFOP, awarded TIG welding certificates to 12 employees in Nacaome, Valle. This initiative strengthens the company's commitment to technical training and continuous improvement in its industrial processes.

The certification validates the skills acquired in one of the most specialized welding techniques, promoting safety, precision, and the professional development of the team.



PHYSICAL THERAPY BRIGADE IN NAMASIGÜE AND NACAOME STRENGTHENS COMMUNITY WELL-BEING

From March 4th to 7th, Fundación Agrolíbano, in collaboration with Honduras Outreach Inc. (HOI), the National Autonomous University of Honduras (UNAH), and the Mayo Clinic of Minnesota, carried out the second physical therapy brigade in the communities of Namasigüe and Nacaome.

During the initiative, over 110 patients received care, including follow-up consultations, initial evaluations, rehabilitation exercises, and personalized counseling. Home visits and talks on educational and workplace inclusion were also conducted.

This effort reaffirms the commitment to health, inclusion, and sustainable development, directly contributing to Sustainable Development Goals #3, 4, 16, and 17.



CULTIVATING OPPORTUNITIES: FUNDACIÓN AGROLÍBANO AND LUIS LANDA SCHOOL JOIN FORCES

Fundación Agrolíbano signed a collaboration agreement with the Luis Landa School of Agriculture to support the technical education of young people in the areas of Agribusiness Development and Agri-food Processing.

This year, six students from communities in Valle and Choluteca will benefit from scholarships covering 50% of their monthly tuition, along with support for clothing, housing, and family guidance to ensure their academic and personal development. The agreement also includes joint initiatives to strengthen health education through the JovenSalud.net platform, promoting overall well-being and the prevention of risky behaviors.

This partnership reflects a strong commitment to inclusive, quality education and contributes to Sustainable Development Goals #1, 4, 5, 10, and 17.

STRENGTHENING CLASSROOMS: NEW TEACHING MATERIALS FOR 28 SCHOOLS

As part of Fundación Agrolíbano's "Together for Education" Program, the renewal of the pedagogical toolkit for the 2025 school year has begun. This year, new teaching materials will be distributed across 50 classrooms in the first education cycle at 14 public schools, in addition to 14 pre-primary centers that will receive consumable resources. These materials enable teachers to implement innovative strategies that enhance the learning process.

This initiative will positively impact more than 1,200 students, supporting their skill development and easing the financial burden on families, who will no longer need to purchase these materials. This effort contributes to Sustainable Development Goals #4 and #17.
